TITLE IV STUDENT AID RECIPIENTS
SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS STANDARDS

Title IV aid is provided to cover the cost of attendance at Alamance Community College. Eligibility must be established by a standard needs analysis as defined by the U. S. Department of Education. Awards are made based on eligibility, cost of attendance, enrollment and payment schedules. To remain eligible, a Pell Grant recipient must comply with the following academic standards.

1. The overall grade point average must be at least 1.5 or higher depending on total hours attempted (see the graduated scale in the academic catalog).
2. At least sixty-seven percent of all attempted hours must be completed to remain eligible. Attempted hours versus completed hours are calculated to determine completion rate.
3. A recipient is given three years in a two year degree program and two years in a diploma program to complete graduation requirements. Totals of 105 hours attempted are allowed for associate degree programs and 60 hours are allowed for diploma programs.

Grade point average, completion rate, and all attempted hours are monitored each year for continual awards.

Recipients will be given every opportunity to retain eligibility with assistance from the counseling staff. Appeals of any suspension may be made to the Director of Financial Aid.
