## Veterinary Medical Technology Rabies Vaccination Acknowledgement Form

In 2022, CVTEA's Rabies Vaccination Requirement went into effect which requires any VMT student to show proof of two (2) doses of the pre-exposure Rabies vaccination series. This requirement is being implemented nationwide to any accredited VMT program. In the past, this vaccine was recommended but it is now a requirement. **What does this mean for you?** 

Any student who is entering, or planning to return to the Alamance Community

College Veterinary Medical Technology Program beginning in the Fall of 2025 will be required to show proof of having two (2) doses of the pre-exposure Rabies

vaccination series. This vaccine can be obtained at most county health offices, doctor's offices, and some pharmacies. We recommend calling these places to ensure they provide this service before making an appointment. When calling, it is important to clarify that you are looking to obtain the pre-exposure Rabies vaccine series, not the post-exposure.

Some insurance providers may help to cover the cost of the vaccine significantly so please be diligent and be sure to contact your insurance provider to see if they will help cover the cost of this preventative, pre-exposure Rabies vaccine. If you currently work in a veterinary clinic, be sure to ask your clinic if they help to cover the cost of pre-exposure Rabies vaccinations.

Any student who is accepted into the VMT Program will not be permitted to enroll in or continue VMT courses at ACC if they do not show proof of two (2) Rabies vaccinations before their Summer (3rd) semester.
