

BRC2 Information Packet

BASIC RIDER COURSE 2 (BRC 2), also known as Experienced Rider Course:

- Basic Rider Course 2 (9 hours): **COST: \$80.00 per person.** If you normally carry a passenger, you may take the BRC2 with your passenger on board. The Passenger will also need to register and sign the waiver forms. **COST FOR THE PASSENGER IS \$30.00**
- **Time/ Location: The course meets at ACC Graham Campus.** (1247 Jimmie Kerr Rd, Graham, NC 27253) **Sat. 8 am-6 pm. , Meet in B222**
- It is recommended that students in the BRC2 class have at least 6 months riding experience or 3,000 miles under their belt.
- To enroll in the BRC2 Motorcycle Course, students must possess a valid motorcycle license or motorcycle endorsement to their license. A learner's permit is also acceptable. Students must also sign appropriate waiver forms and have all the items in the Course Requirements below.
- **Registrations are taken on a first come, first-served basis. Refunds will only be available if made at least 24 hours in advance.**
IMPORTANT NOTE!! Your tuition fee will not be refunded if you fail to show up for class or if you fail complete the course. If you become a safety risk to yourself or others, you will not be permitted to continue and will not receive a refund.
- **Classes are rarely canceled because of weather. You should be prepared to ride regardless of the weather.**

Basic Rider Course 2 Requirements

All participants in ACC's Motorcycle Safety Foundation courses must meet the following requirements:

1. Complete and sign all waiver forms.
2. Be on time. The BRC2 class starts promptly at 8:00 am. We recommend you arrive 15 minutes early.

The following will be verified at class.

3. Possess a valid motorcycle license, motorcycle endorsement to their license, or motorcycle learner's permit.
4. Provide a street legal, properly licensed motorcycle for the range exercises. The motorcycle must pass a visual safety inspection on the morning of the class. **3-Wheeled Motorcycles are not permitted.**
5. Provide registration information and proof of insurance for your motorcycle on the morning of the class.
6. **Have proper riding gear: no exceptions!**
 - Wear DOT approved helmet with eye protection. (ACC has loaner helmets if needed.)
 - Wear over-the-ankle leather footwear (must have thick padding around the ankle).
 - **NO HIGH TOP SNEAKERS!**
 - Wear long-sleeved shirt or jacket
 - Wear long pants (preferably leather or denim).
Wear properly fitted full-fingered
