

Information for ACC's CDL-A Program

- All training will take place at Cross Country Truck Driving School (CCTDS) located at: 2609 Tucker Street, Burlington, 27215.
- Class meets from 8 am - 5 pm. Please arrive 15 minutes early (7:45 am) for your first class and check in at the front desk.
- The part-time program will meet on Saturday and Sunday for a minimum of 12 weeks. Full-time students will meet Saturdays- Wednesday for a minimum of 5 weeks. Students must complete at least 160 hours of training.
- Testing will be scheduled by CCTS at the completion of the class and will take place at CCTS.
- For the driving portion of this class, you will need to obtain your CDL permit from the Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV). The cost of the permit is \$64.75 and you will need to pass 3 written tests in order to receive it. It is NOT necessary to have your permit before the first day of class. The instructors at Cross Country will help you prepare for the test.
- You will need to have a Department of Transportation physical and drug screen. It is also not necessary to have this completed before you begin your training, but you must have it before obtaining your CDL - A.
- Payment must be received in full by the Tuesday that proceeds your first class. Payment can be made at Dillingham Center (1304 Plaza Drive, Burlington, 27215) or by calling 336-506-4149.
