### Training a Network of Talent

#### Highlights:

- The graduating class of 2025 included **896 curriculum completers** earning **642** associate degrees, **92** diplomas, and **408** certificates, as well as **71** students who earned GED or HiSET diplomas, including **two** from the Alamance County Detention Center.
- Graduation rate **increased by 6%** and transfer-out rate **increased by 9%** over the last two years.
- **New initiatives** like IET (Integrated Education & Training) and Parent Promise helped adult learners and parents **achieve life-changing milestones**.

## UNPRECEDENTED ENROLLMENT GROWTH



### Build Pathways for Lifelong Learning

#### Notables:

- Enrollment grew **14%** for curriculum programs in 2024 and ACC continues to see growth.
